 - 14.5 million clusters



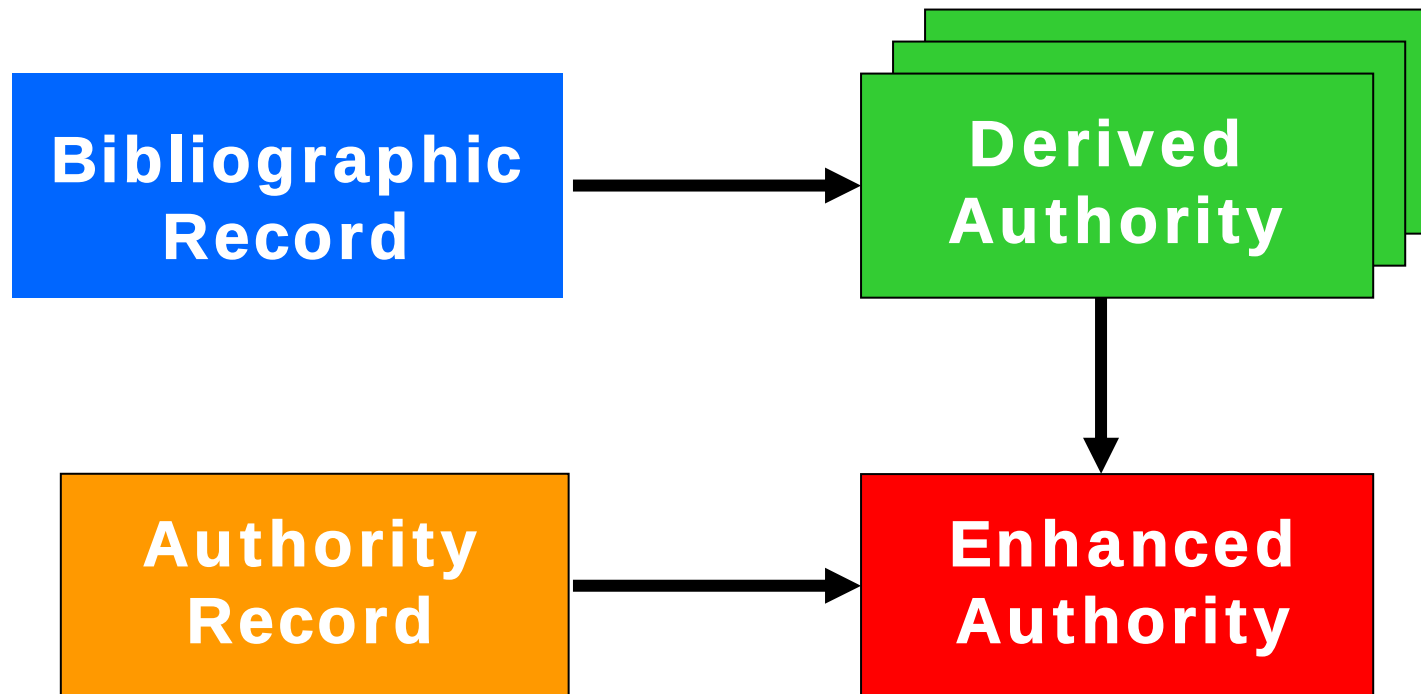

Cite as source in 670 \$a, for example:

- BNF in VIAF, 12 June 2011
- Nat. Lib. of Australia in VIAF, 5 Feb. 2011
- VIAF, 6 July 2011



Next steps for VIAF

- Better searching
- More “Linked data”
 - Related persons as in WorldCat Identities, Wikipedia, etc.
- Participants beyond libraries
 - Rights management agencies, Publishers
 - Museums, Archives
- More name types
 - Now: Personal and Corporate names, “Uniform” titles (work/expression) with some Geographic as jurisdictions
 - Family names
 - Geographic names
 - ... not topical terms



SKOS

- Simple Knowledge Organization System
 - “Provides a model for expressing the basic structure and content of concept schemes such as thesauri, classification schemes, subject heading lists, taxonomies, folksonomies, and other similar types of controlled vocabulary”—*SKOS Primer*
